Southern Art House Tour Terms and Conditions

Tickets

- 1 You must have a ticket for admission to the houses on the tour.
- 2 By purchasing or using a ticket you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.
- Tickets cannot be purchased at the houses on the tour. Details of how to purchase tickets are on our website www.southernarthousetour.co.nz.
- Only the ticket holder can use the ticket. Tickets cannot be shared. On the day of the tour each ticket holder must attend John McGlashan College between 9 and 10am for registration. Upon registration a tour wristband will be issued to each ticket holder for admission to houses on the tour. Each wristband may only be used by the person it was issued to.
- You may be photographed during the tour and those photographs may be used for our future marketing and promotional purposes.
- 6 No ticket refunds will be given unless the tour is rescheduled or cancelled.
- We may reschedule or cancel the tour at our discretion. If we do so, then refunds will be available to ticket holders until 5pm on the earlier of the 14th day after the date of the tour which has been rescheduled or cancelled or the day three days prior to the rescheduled tour date.
- To request a refund email southernarthouses@gmail.com. A refund will only be provided to the person who paid for the ticket. Proof of payment may be requested as a precondition to refund. Tickets are void from the time a refund is requested.
- 9 If we cancel the tour, then artwork may be offered for sale at www.southernarthousetour.co.nz or by other means, on such terms as we see fit.

Viewing

- 11 Art can be viewed at the houses on the tour on Saturday 2 November 2024 between 10am-4pm.
- 12 Artwork for sale will be marked as such and is listed on our website www.southernarthousetour.co.nz. All other displayed artwork is not for sale.
- 13 Entry to each house may be declined at the discretion of the homeowner or a tour volunteer. The directions of a homeowner or tour volunteer must be

- followed, including a direction to leave the house. No refund will be given if you are denied admission or directed to leave a house.
- All written instructions at each house must be followed. Entry to each house is limited to the areas marked for art viewing by ticket holders.
- 15 If your act or omission causes damage to a house, an artwork or other chattels or vehicles, then you are liable for all resulting loss suffered by the owner of the item damaged.

Purchase of artwork

- Art can be purchased at each venue and paid for by EFTPOS, credit or debit card. We accept Mastercard and VISA.
- 17 Payment must be made at the time of purchase. Artwork will not be removed from sale without payment. Until payment is made there is no sale contract, and we remain free to sell the artwork to another person.
- 18 If you purchase an artwork, then you must collect it from the house at which it was displayed between 4pm and 5pm on the day of the tour. You must present your receipt for payment before removing the artwork.
- 19 Risk in a purchased artwork passes to the purchaser at the earlier of collection or 5pm on the day of the tour.
- If you cannot collect your artwork between 4pm and 5pm on the day of the tour, then you must phone Christine Nock 0211393074 to make alternative arrangements.
- 21 Even if it is agreed that your artwork will not be collected until later, risk passes to you at 5pm on the day of the tour.
- 22 Title to purchased artwork passes to the purchaser when the purchaser collects the artwork.
- If you do not collect artwork you have purchased by 5pm on the 14th day after the date of the tour, then we will re-sell the work at a gallery of our choosing and refund to you the amount we sell it for less our costs of sale. We will have no liability to you for any loss or delay on re-sale. If after reasonable efforts we are unable to obtain from you bank account details for that refund then the proceeds of re-sale will belong to us.
